Indications

The Universal Retrograde Nail System is intended for the fixation of fractures where flexibility of the implant is
desired. This includes fractures of: Lower extremity diaphyseal fractures of children and smallstatured adults,
upper extremity diaphysealfractures in both, adults and children as well as some metaphyseal fractures, such as
radial neck, proximal humerusand supracondylar humerusfractures. Please refer to the surgical technique for a
complete list of indications and contraindications.

Features & Benefits

- Minimal invasive technique and biomechanical stability allow early functional exercise
- Type II anodized Titanium Alloy for enhanced biomechanical and biomedical performance
- Curved nail tip allows maximal guidance without blocking in the intramedullary canal
- Tapered tip and concave inner nail tip for anchoring in metaphyseal bone and capturing fracture fragments
